### The Skills Development Facilitator (SDF) of your Company

- Develop a Workplace Skills Plan (WSP) annually for the Employer, in line with SETA requirements
- Submit WSP to the relevant SETA by due date end of April of each year
- Advise the Employer on the implementation of the WSP
- Assist the Employer to draft an Annual Training Report (ATR) on the implementation of the WSP which complies with the SETA's requirements
- Advise the Employer on the quality assurance requirements set by the SETA
- Act as a contact person between the Employer and the Sector SETA
- Serve as a resource with regard to all aspects of skills development.

SDF's can be staff members or an External Service Provider who is appointed by the Employer for SDF functions.

To benefit from Mandatory grant, SDF's can now apply obo the Employer by submitting the Company **WSP (01.04.2020-31.03.2021) & ATR (01.04.2019-31.03.2020).**
