General Description

The chlorine in **Alkafoam CL** serves as a peptizing agent for proteins. This enables the product to break down and solubilize proteinaceous scales on food contact surfaces.

Alkafoam CL has been Internationally & Independently tested and assessed as safe for use in the food processing industry when used as directed.

Usage Recommendations

Alkafoam CL is used between 1% – 4% by volume of water, at room temperature, and can be foamed onto process areas.

Safety Precautions

Alkafoam CL is a chlorinated caustic alkali.

The concentrated product is corrosive and an oxidant and can cause eye damage and skin irritation. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

Store in plastic containers with vented bungs. Store in a cool dry area, out of direct sunlight.

Do not store near acids. Contact or mixing with acids may cause liberation of Chlorine gas (toxic).

Wear suitable protective clothing when handling **Alkafoam CL**.
